Please find below instructions from the UAE Government regarding restrictions on certain Flagged vessels in entering UAE waters.

NOTIFICATION TO SHIPPING AGENTS – NTA 05/2011

FLAGS RESTRICTED FROM ENTERING UAE PORTS

Please note the following instructions regarding vessels registered in the following countries for entry into UAE Ports:
